## Merchantville Police Department

 2022 Summary Report of Internal Affairs ComplaintsIn accordance with Requirement 10 of the New Jersey Attorney General's Internal Affairs Guideline, the Merchantville Police Department is releasing to the public a report that summarizes the allegations received and the investigations concluded for 2022. The report will also provide a brief synopsis of all complaints where a fine or suspension of 10 days or more was assessed to an Officer.

During 2022, there were 6 complaints received. The public made 6 complaint and 0 were generated internally.
The chart below reflects the 6 complaints that were investigated and closed during 2022. One complaint (Other Criminal Violation) was carried over from 2021 and was determined to be unfounded.

Possible Dispositions of Internal Affairs complaints include:

2. Not Sustained: The investigation failed to disclose sufficient evidence to clearly prove or disprove the allegation.
3. Sustained: The investigation disclosed sufficient evidence to prove the allegation and the actions of the officer violated a provision of the agency's rules and regulations or procedures.
4. Unfounded: The alleged incident did not occur.

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The following is a synopsis of the sustained findings during the year 2022 where a fine or suspension of 10 days or more was assessed to an Officer:
